


## Online result SARS-CoV-2 via BROWSER

You have just had a smear test for novel coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2) infection. You can access your result using any browser.

1. Navigate to <https://onlineportal.medilab.at>
2. Click on "Schnellbefund ansehen"
3. Scan your QR Code or type the number in manually



4. Once you have received your result, you can download the medical report under Download PDF. To unlock the download, you must verify your first name, last name and date of birth.





Your result:

**Result positive:** Please stay at home, avoid social contacts, pay attention to proper hand hygiene, keep a distance (2.0 meters) when in contact with family members and wear a mouth-nose mask. Wait for the call from the health authority. In case of acute deterioration please call 1450.

**Result negative:** There is currently no evidence of infection with the novel coronavirus. Nonetheless, please follow the general hygiene recommendations in order to protect yourself and others.

**Result unclear:** The test must be repeated.

## Online report SARS-CoV-2 via App

You have just had a smear test taken for an infection with the novel coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2). You can view the result on your smartphone:

1. Download the **Medilab Onlinebefunde** App via the QR-Code (or in the Play-Store/App-Store). 
2. Open the Medilab Onlinebefunde App and click  on „SARS-CoV-2 Resultatsabfrage“.
3. Confirm that the app is allowed to take pictures and videos.
4. Scan the QR-Code again.
5. If your results are still being processed, you can request a push message. You will then be notified after completion.
6. View your result.




Once you have received your result, you can download the medical report under Download PDF. To unlock the download, you must verify your first name, last name and date of birth.
